
Telling Time Tips

To tell time with an analog clock:

First, find the **hour** hand. (It's the shorter one.) Find the number it's pointing at. This is the current **hour**.

* If the hour hand is between numbers, the **smaller** number is the current hour. So, if the hour hand is between the 12 and the 1, the hour is 12.

Next, look at the **minute** hand. Find the number it's pointing to. You may have to count the lines between numbers. This is the current **minute**.



To tell time with a digital clock:

The number to the **left** of the colon is the **hour**.

The number to the **right** of the colon is the **minute**.
